Definite & Indefinite Master **el, la, los, las, un, una, unos, unas**

1. Definite Articles (THE)

Use for SPECIFIC items - "THE cat" not just any cat!

Articles must match the gender and number of the noun

el masculine singular

el gato (the cat)

/ehl GAH-toh/

la feminine singular

la casa (the house)

/lah KAH-sah/

los masculine plural

los gatos (the cats)

/lohs GAH-tohs/

las feminine plural

las casas (the houses)

/lahs KAH-sahs/

2. Indefinite Articles (A/AN/SOME)

Use for ANY item - "A book" not a specific one!

Also must match gender and number

un masculine singular

un libro (a book)

/oon LEE-broh/

una feminine singular

una mesa (a table)

/OO-nah MEH-sah/

unos masculine plural

unos libros (some books)

/OO-nohs LEE-brohs/

unas feminine plural

unas mesas (some tables)

/OO-nahs MEH-sahs/

3. Gender & Number Agreement



Key Rule:

Articles MUST match the noun in both gender (masculine/feminine)
AND number (singular/plural)!

✓ el libro	✗ la libro	(libro is masculine)
✓ la mesa	✗ el mesa	(mesa is feminine)
✓ los libros	✗ el libros	(plural needs plural article)
✓ unas casas	✗ una casas	(plural needs plural article)

4. Real Conversation Examples



At the Café

"Quiero **un café** " - I want a coffee (any coffee)

/kee-EH-roh oon kah-FEH/

"¿Dónde está **el café** ?" - Where is the coffee? (the specific one)



Shopping

"Necesito **una camisa** " - I need a shirt (any shirt)

/neh-seh-SEE-toh OO-nah kah-MEE-sah/

"Me gusta **la camisa azul** " - I like the blue shirt (specific one)

5. Common Mistakes to Avoid

 **la problema**

Some words ending in -a are masculine!

 **el problema**

 **el casas**

Plural nouns need plural articles

 **las casas**

 **un mesas**

Articles must match in number

 **unas mesas**
